CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1 The tournament will be run in accordance with the Badminton England Tournament Regulations.
- 2 Competitors must be qualified to represent the County under the Senior County Championship Regulations and must be a member of Badminton England.
- 3 A separate entry form must be completed by each competitor. Doubles entries will not be accepted without an entry from each player. Competitors wanting a partner should enter "partner wanted" on the entry form.
- 4 The completed form must be sent by post or e-mail to the Tournament Secretary by the closing date. Payment should be made by BACS to the CCBA account - Sort Code 77-17-21, Account No. 12008460 (please include your name as reference).
- 5 Late entries will only be accepted at the Referee's discretion and if numbers permit.
- 6 Acceptances: A list of accepted competitors, together with reporting times for their first match, will be posted on the CCBA website - www.cheshirebadminton.org - at least 3 days prior to the tournament date.
- 7 Entry is at the competitor's own risk and by signing the entry form they acknowledge that to the best of their knowledge they are healthy and fit to compete.
- 8 Provided that at least 36 hours notice is given to the Tournament Secretary, competitors who may be prevented from playing by illness, injury or other unforeseen cause shall have their entry fees returned less a £5 handling charge. No refund will be paid if the withdrawal is within 36 hours of the start of the tournament.
- 9 Competitors must report to the Referee immediately on arrival and be ready to play when called. Any competitor not ready to play is liable to scratched.
- 10 The tournament will not start before 9am and play should finish no later than 8pm. This a one day tournament and all events will be played to a conclusion on Saturday 23rd September.
- 11 Clothing must be acceptable badminton clothing and its suitability will be at the discretion of the Referee.
- 12 The draw will be seeded and the early stages of the events will be played in pools. The top two in each pool will go forward to the knock out stages. Where sufficient entries allow, a Plate competition will be run in the Mens' Singles and Womens' Singles events, for all players finishing outside the top two in each group. The format of the later stages will be at the discretion of the Referee. All matches will be the best of three games.
- 13 The Referee will set the order of play for the tournament and reserves the right to cancel the tournament and/or amend these conditions, in particular the format of play, if circumstances dictate. Any amendments will be notified to the entrants.
- 14 Badminton England and Cheshire County Badminton Association require all players and attendees at the Tournaments to agree to abide by Badminton England policies and codes of conduct.
- 15 The Tournament Referee's decision in all matters relating to the tournament shall be final.
